Best Recent Photograph of Deceased (for hair styling, cosmetics, and memorial folders)

Any Burial or Life Insurance Policies

Deceased's Full Name, City and State of Birth, Social Security Number, and if a Veteran, the Discharge Papers (DD-214)

Parents Names and places of birth (inclusive of Mother's Maiden Name)

List of Survivors

Pallbearers Names (at least six, but can be more)

Minister(s)/Pastor(s)/Priest(s) Names

Cemetery Information

Dentures (if Deceased wore them the majority of the time)

Full Set of Underclothing

Deceased's Dress, Suit or Desired Clothing for Burial (Shoes are optional)

Eyeglasses (if Deceased wore them the majority of the time)

Jewelry (if desired)
